

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY: Covid 19 Risk Assessment.

You will have to be a member or Spotlight or a student at a recognised Drama School. Please provide proof of your student ID.

Please arrive at your session 10 mins early. On arrival you will have your temperature taken and asked to sanitise your hands. If your temperature is on or above 37.8C you will be refused entry and lose your deposit. Only one person allowed in the studio at anytime so please do not bring a friend or relation. There are no indoor waiting areas. Please drive to the session if at all possible. Parking is available and is free.

Please wear your mask at all times other than when you are having your picture taken.

There will be no tea or coffee so please bring whatever refreshment you want with you.

There are also **no toilet or washing facilities.**

As the studio is at home and both my wife and I are high risk we simply can't take the chance of 'touch areas' being affected. It is also protecting you from passing on the infection to other clients.

I have built a daylight studio outside in the garden. This environment is the least risky in terms of passing on infection so you can feel comfortable during the shooting process. I will be wearing a mask at all times.

The changing area is annexed to the house and though warm and dry it is quite small. There is space to touch up make up, please bring your own hairdryer and curlers if necessary. Boys can shave using an electric razor. Please bring a towel to collect the debris. There are no ironing facilities. The area will be sanitised after each client.

The session will last no more than 1 hr but that is ample time for three changes of clothes.

Having said all this please come prepared, enjoy your session and let's create some great headshots.
